- Solfa/Solfège - pitch training
- Improvisation - vocal and instrumental

Sessions in the three core disciplines will be offered for the following range of experience:

- For those with little or no experience of the Dalcroze approach
- For those with some experience of Dalcroze Eurhythmics and those wishing to study for the Certificate exams
- For those with considerable experience of Dalcroze Eurhythmics and those working at Certificate level and above
